

Re: SB 905 Five year pilot program to extend closing hours for bars and restaurants to 4:00 a.m.

Please be advised the board of the Studio City Residents Association voted unanimously to oppose SB 905. Studio City's many restaurants are primarily located in the commercial corridors along Ventura Blvd and along Moorpark Street. Both these corridors are immediately adjacent to suburban residential neighborhoods, which would experience noise and other disruption as a result of these extended hours.

MOTION: The board of the Studio City Residents Association is opposed to SB905, which would include the city of Los Angeles in a pilot program which would authorize, with or without conditions, the selling, giving or purchasing of alcoholic beverages at the licensed premises between the hours of 2am and 4am. Studio City's many restaurants are primarily located in the commercial corridors along Ventura Blvd and along Moorpark Street. Both these corridors are immediately adjacent to suburban residential neighborhoods, which would experience noise and other disruption as a result of these extended hours.
